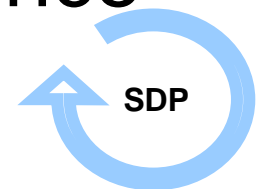


What is School Development Planning and what are the outcomes?



School Development Planning

- SDP is a process governed by statute
- SDP is a **PLANNING** process that produces a working document
- SDP enables the work of a school to proceed and progress with coherence

How does the School Development Planning Process work?

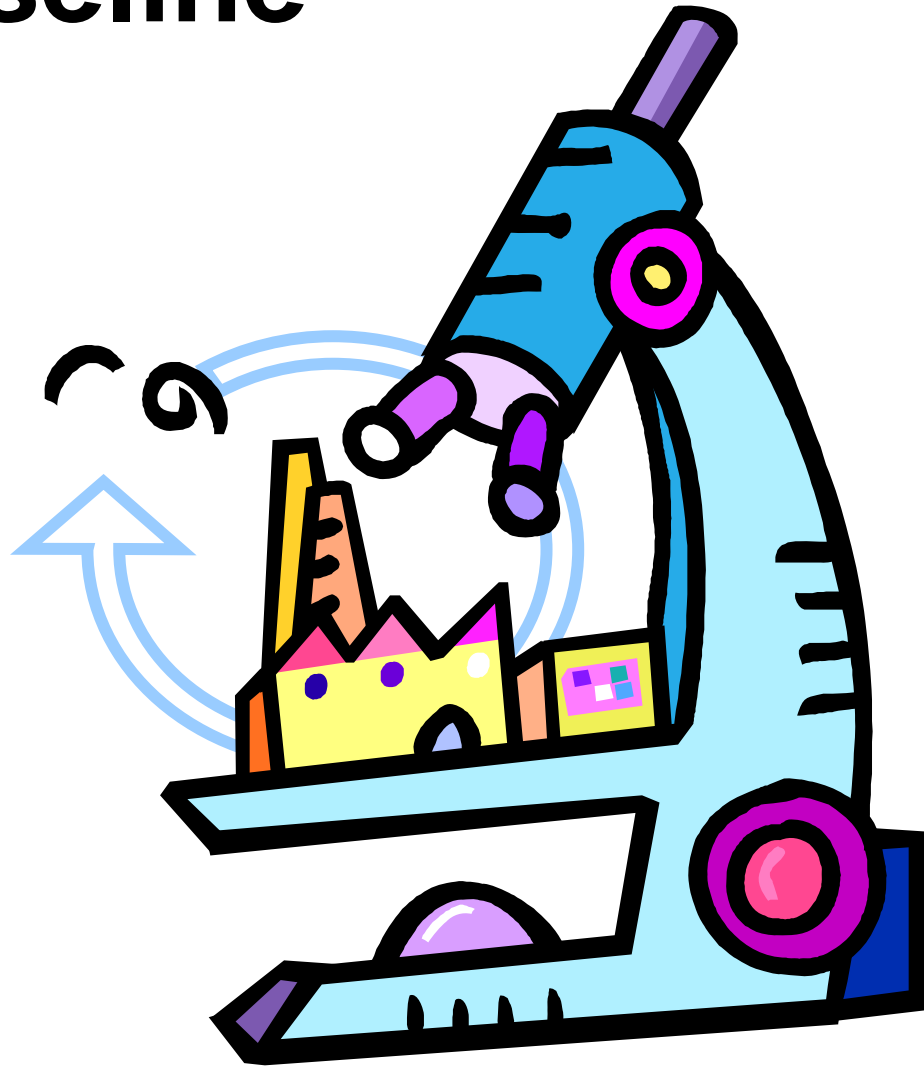


SDP Process is a Cycle

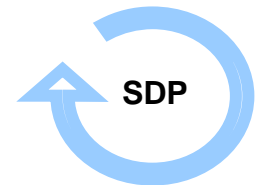


What is in a School Development Plan?

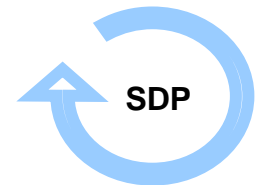


The Plan

- Is a written document structured according to 2005/No 303 Education (SDP) Regulations (NI) 2005
- Includes the elements listed in Regulation 3: Schedule
- Is a 3 year plan, with the current year detailed and Action Planned.



What are Governors' Roles and Responsibilities?

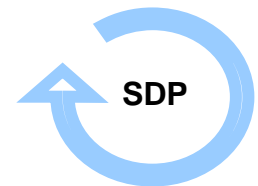


Governor Roles and Responsibilities

- Statutory responsibility to prepare and approve the School's SDP and any revisions (Scheme of M'ment Article 12)
- Minute this approval
- R&R summarised in DE SDP

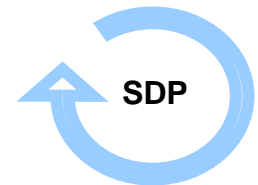

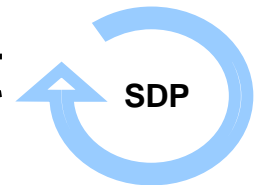
